Hello, Colorado Driving Society!

My name is Orrill Speaker and I am your Youth Representative. I have been driving with CDS for 10 years now, with horses ranging from 34" to over 18 hands. I drive both single and teams. I have participated in draft horse driving almost as long, just less frequently.

My first big adventure as the Colorado Driving Society Youth Representative was to attend the Big Thunder Draft Horse Show both as your representative and an exhibitor.

I began the show by attending the exhibitor dinner the night before the show. I enjoyed talking to others about driving draft horses at open driving competitions such as CDEs and derby drives.

The morning the show started I was asked by show management to assist in handing out the show sponsorship signs to be placed upon the draft horse hitch wagons. This was a great opportunity to meet many drivers of the hitches. I later rode up on Kiowa Creek Coaches hitch wagon during men's team class and unicorn hitch to help keep the lines straight and assist with the teams in lineup. I was announced as the CDS Youth Representative during both classes and had several people come talk with me about our club after the classes ended for the evening.

On Saturday, I assisted with braiding horses (draft horse show classes require mane and tail braids), harnessing and hooking horses to vehicles. I was able to answer many questions about differences in CDE events and draft horse events and activities.

On Sunday I drove for Kiowa Creek Coaches in the amateur cart class and was then able to assist the Colorado Draft Horse Association's Youth Representative in presenting ribbons in the afternoon. I had time to speak with some of the audience about CDS activities between awards presentations. At the end of the show I was offered the opportunity to ride with the winning eight horse hitch as your Youth Representative.

I had a good time sharing what a wonderful group of driving enthusiasts we have and presenting new driving opportunities to my friends in the draft horse world.

I look forward to sharing the driving adventures from the National Western Stock Show in next month's newsletter.

C arriage driving is more than just a big draft horse pulling a bunch of sightseers around town. Carriage driving is one of the fastest growing equestrian sports today, and can be as difficult or simple as you choose to make it: a simple picnic drive with friends, a trail "ride" through a park, an exhilarating cross-country marathon, a challenging obstacle course, a dressage test as sophisticated as the highest level of ridden dressage.

You can drive any size horse or pony, from miniature to draft, or drive a mule or donkey instead. Put that lawn ornament or out-grown pony to work! Have an older horse that needs a different exercise program? Put those dreams of yours on a carriage seat instead of a saddle! You and your horse can learn new ways to enjoy this equine sport.

We'll take care of the layout.)
- 4. For help recruiting volunteers, contact the volunteer coordinator (below) two months prior to the event with a list of

the positions to be filled (set-up, scribe, timer, cone setters, volunteer judges, announcer, photographer, etc.)

- 5. Arrange for a volunteer to take photographs or contact the newsletter editor about photographs.
- 6. After your event, please send a report about scores, awards, number of entries, etc. to the newsletter editor.
- 7. To be reimbursed by the club for any expenses you incur, you must provide a receipt and a CDS reimbursement form, available from the event coordinator.

Items that are donated require a receipt for the value of the item and the word "Donated" written on the receipt for tax purposes. This can include a judge's fee if the judge normally charges but chooses to donate the service to CDS.
